This scholarship award is for \$1,400 for the 2022-23 academic year and may be renewed up for up to (4) four consecutive years if successful academic progress is met, as defined by Altrusa International of Longview-Kelso. - 4. Funds will be forwarded to your college or university after Altrusa International of Longview-Kelso has received your acceptance of the scholarship in the first year or your grade report in the second through fourth years.
